First Visit: 6-8 weeks old

Feline Panleukopenia, Chlamydia, Rhinotracheitis, Calicivirus, worm w/ Pyrantel

Optional: Ask your veterinarian if you are unsure if these services are necessary for your new pet

Feline Leukemia Virus Test *(test is optional but recommended in multi-cat households)*

Feline Leukemia Virus vaccination *(recommended for out door cats & multi-cat households)*

Second Visit: 10-12 weeks old

Feline Panleukopenia, Chlamydia, Rhinotracheitis, Calicivirus, worm w/ Pyrantel

Optional:

Feline Leukemia virus vaccination is boosted if give at 6-8 weeks

Third Visit: 16 weeks old

Rabies

Yearly:

Feline Panleukopenia, Chlamydia, Rhinotracheitis, Calicivirus, worm w/ Pyrantel, and Rabies

Heartworm Preventative

Frontline Plus for fleas & ticks

Note Rabies is boosted at one year. Than is every 3 years

Other:

Spay Female (6 months old)

Neuter Male (6 months old)

Front Declaw (8 weeks old – 6 months old)

Front Declaw (Over 6 months old)

Fecal exam (recommended yearly)
